

Automatic Disciplinary / Fines list Football Association of Pretoria

With the exception of player red and yellow card offences, the following can be avoided if Clubs, Managers and Referee's do the simple tasks required for the Leagues to run smoothly.

NB: These fines are over and above any normal / affiliation fees paid to the association, and may be adjusted through appealing to the Protest and Misconduct Committee.

ABBREV.	FINE	OFFENCE, ADDITIONAL DISCIPLINARY AND LIMIT ON FINE
NAG	R500.00	Not attending Monthly General Meetings
NAGM	R500.00	Not attending AGM and Special General Meetings
NIN	R100.00	Not informing the Association of change of Club data
NAF	R300.00	Not arriving for fixture- plus points given to opposition
WFL	R1000.00	Withdrawing a team from League after acceptance
LEL	R250.00	Late entry to League (if accepted)
FNP	R200.00	Fielding non registered players.
RSF	R200.00	Both Clubs - rearranging fixture without approval + disciplinary
NPR	R30.00	Not phoning/faxing in results by 12h00 on Monday following match
NDR	R30.00	Not delivering/Faxing team return within 5 days of the match
ITR	R15.00	Improper Team Return card -all data not completed (Date, league, etc)
NADC	R250	Not attending a Disciplinary Hearing
RLC	R30	Replacement of a lost card
WRN	R15.00	Wrong player registration number stated on card - max fine: R75.00
Y5	R50.00	5th Yellow card offence – Suspension / Fine to be determined by DC.
R1	R50.00	1st Red card offence – Suspension / Fine to be determined by DC.
R2	R100.00	2nd Red card offence – Suspension / Fine to be determined by DC.
RNP	R100.00	Not paying match Referee - plus Referee's match fee
GNP	R300.00	Game Not Played; Team not ready at scheduled start fined and points to opposition. Not ready meaning; At least 7 players kitted and ready to play and/or Cards of ALL starting players not available and/or Team return not completed in full.

NOTE:

1. The Association will inform clubs when player has 5th yellow card.
2. All offences not listed above - disciplinary hearing.
